PERISPINAL ETANERCEPT TREATMENT PATIENT SUCCESS

We are regularly contacted by people seeking Perispinal Etanercept treatment for themselves or a family member, and they continue to report back with their improvements after treatment at the Institute of Neurological Recovery (INR) in the USA which is wonderful. CLINICAL TRIAL NEWS

And the question on everyone's lips is – what about the Griffith University School of Medicine Perispinal Etanercept clinical trial for Stroke patients which is being funded by the SRTF? When is it starting? It has been incredibly frustrating waiting for the official start date. As the result of work by the scientific team who are working on this exciting project, there has been a revision of the inclusion criteria to improve the scientific rigor.

This is part of an email which was sent to people at the start of July 2016 who had expressed an interest as a potential participant in the clinical trial:

"The study trial at this stage is in the final process of being modified to focus on a particular group of stroke patients with anatomically well-defined problems and clinical characteristics - namely those who have right hemisphere stroke with left sided hemiparesis (weakness of left arm and left leg). This is in order to give it the best chances of success in the trial. These represent a specific subgroup of stroke patients who have had a stroke in the territory of the right middle cerebral artery (right MCA stroke). This type of stroke affects the left side of the body, causing left-sided weakness.

The reason for this focus is because these patients have characteristic neurological dysfunction that can be evaluated for a particular set of outcomes in a more straightforward manner, comparing before and after treatment. Thus, left hemiparesis will be a specific inclusion criteria for entry into the study. Hence, post-stroke subjects with these specific characteristics are the only ones who will be eligible for the proposed study. We expect that our trial should be underway in the next few months. Please await further advice, which will be sent out at that time. Please also understand that we are not calling for applications at this time for the trial and do not have the staff available to respond to individual inquiries made either by phone or email, in the meantime."

From my conversations with the research team, they are awaiting final approval from the Australian Stroke Trials Network which should be received any day. I understand that the Griffith research team is in the final stages of preparation for this clinical trial.

We will email an update as soon as we have the official word of a start date!
